
Process flow charts for the accreditation of new medical education programs in Canada




General overview of new school accreditation process





Applicant > Candidate Status Process




^{*} Window for re-submission is between 12 & 18 months of date of denied candidate status

Candidate > Preliminary Accreditation




^{*} If students are admitted after preliminary accreditation was denied, the program forfeits its eligibility for reapplication as a new program and cannot apply for CACMS accreditation until its medical educational program has graduated at least one class.

Preliminary > Provisional Accreditation



Note: Re-application for applicant status & new fees required (no sooner than 1 year from final withdrawal decision)

Provisional > Full Accreditation



^{*} School must achieve Full Accreditation within 5 years of receiving Provisional status otherwise re-application and new fees are required
